



CIC 25th Anniversary

Built Environment Photography Competition

The Construction Industry Council's 25th anniversary built environment photography competition is now open and we invite entries from aspiring and professional photographers alike, responding creatively to one, two or all three of the following categories:

1. The changing face of construction: building the past 25 years
2. Visualising the future: what will UK 2050 look like?
3. Diversity in construction: aspirations of a generation

Submissions are limited to three photographs per photographer across the categories and must be the photographer's own original work. Each photograph submitted must be accompanied by the photographer's name, contact details, the category you wish to enter and a brief description (maximum 50 words) including date and location.

Entries may be digitally enhanced, must not exceed 5Mb per photo, must be in a JPEG format and sent via www.wetransfer.com using email address enquiries@cic.org.uk, and stating '*Photography Competition*' in the subject line. Please address any difficulties you may encounter making submissions, to the same email address enquiries@cic.org.uk.

The competition closes at 12 noon on 1 October 2013. Incorrect and late submissions will not be accepted.

A judging panel of press and built environment experts from CIC and its member institutions will select a winner from each of the categories, from a shortlist of nine photographs (three from each of the three categories) and one overall winner, based on originality, composition and interpretation.

The Prizes:

- The three individual category winners will each receive a £250 prize.
- The overall winner will receive an additional prize of £250; a total prize purse of £500.
- All nine shortlisted photographs will be on public display at The Building Centre Café Gallery from 28 October to 30 November 2013.

The photographers of the nine shortlisted entries will be contacted via email by 21 October and invited to a special viewing on 28 October 2013 at the Building Centre, 26 Store Street, London, WC1E 7BT, when the category winners will be announced.

The winning photographers will be invited to the CIC Anniversary Gala Evening on 7 November 2013 in Central London (venue tbc) where the overall winner will be announced and the prizes awarded.

The results of the competition will be available on the CIC website on the following dates: the shortlisted photographs will be announced on 28th October, the category winners on 29 October and the overall winner on 8 November 2013 - www.cic.org.uk

Terms and Conditions:

- This competition is free to enter and open to UK residents only, aged 18 or over.
- CIC employees and family members may not enter.
- The judges' decision is final and binding.
- Photographers retain all rights to the photographs submitted to the competition; by entering the competition the photographers grant CIC a non-exclusive, irrevocable licence to reproduce, enlarge, publish or exhibit, on any media, the images for any purpose connected with CIC and the competition.
- Entry into the competition means acceptance of the terms and conditions of entry.
